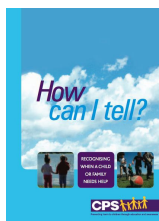

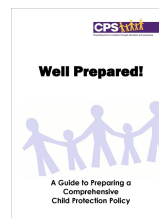

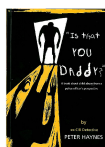


## Is That You Daddy?

A book about child abuse from a police officer's perspective.



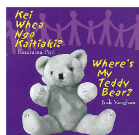
## Where's My Teddy Bear? CD
