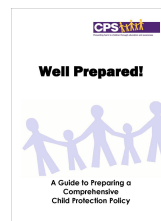


How Can I Tell

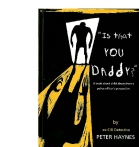


Safe Not Sorry

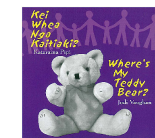


Is That You Daddy?
